riangle important safety instructions

When using electric products, basic precautions should always be followed, including the following:

- DO NOT LIGHT CANDLE WHEN USING CANDLE WARMER LAMP.
- Do not operate when the appliance is not working properly or when it has been damaged in any manner.
- The glass lamp shade is hot when turned on. Do not touch it at anytime.
- · Keep lamp away from flammable materials.
- \cdot Turn off, unplug and allow lamp to cool before replacing the GU10 bulb and before cleaning (use a soft cloth)
- · Do not attempt to move candle warmer lamp with melted candle.
- To protect against risk of electrical shock do not put cord, plug or lamp in water or other liquid.
- \cdot Close supervision is necessary when any appliance is used by or near children.
- · Do not use outdoors.
- Do not let cord hang over edge of table or counter.
- To disconnect, grip plug and pull from wall outlet.
- Never pull on cord to disconnect.
- · Do not use appliance for other than intended use.
- · Do not leave appliance unattended when in use.

Light source: 110V GU10 Halogen bulbs x 2PCS Candle warmer lamp x 1PC

*Socket holes 2H 4H 8H Brightness Timer increase Long/short *Make sure the lamp is unplugged press Brightness decrease Long/short press ON / OFF GU10 bulb Twist in the bulb Adjust the brightness Adjust the height of the stem

then plug in the lamp

Adjust the brightness and set the timer

Adjust the height of the stem to fit your candle and enjoy the long-lasting fragrance

Tips :

- The candle's surface slowly melts after 3-5 minutes when powered on.
- Recommend use: 2-4 hours each time.
- Trim the remaining candle wick once the wax has cooled and solidified.
- If candle wax spills on candle warmer use a plastic spatula or credit card to scrape the wax off. Use a paper towel to rub off any remaining wax.
 Do not use metal or any other sharp objects to scrape off melted wax.
- When scent starts to diminish from your candle, melt 1 inch of candle from the top and pour melted wax into an empty metal or glass container and discard.
